



LOCATION—In the Warm Springs Valley of the Virginia Alleghanies, elevation 2,300 feet above sea level. On the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway midway between Washington and Cincinnati. Trains from all principal cities. On U.S. Route 220. Daily flights from New York, Washington, D.C., Cincinnati, Ohio and Atlanta, Georgia via Piedmont Airlines.

SPORTS FACILITIES—Swimming, Indoor and Outdoor Pools and Beach at the hotel; our historic Warm Springs Pools, five miles away, water 98°. Golf, Homestead, Cascades and Lower Cascades Courses (all 18 holes). Tennis, eight courts, three En-Tout-Cas, four Teniko Royal and one all-weather surface court. Riding, horses from our own stables, bred and trained for this region. Driving, surreys and buckboards available at rates according to time, distance and vehicle. Skeet, or 16 Yard Traps at the Skeet Field. Fishing, Cascades Trout stream. Ten Pin Bowling, 8 new alleys with automatic pin-setting equipment. Lawn Bowling (2 courts), adjacent to the Casino. All-winter Skiing on manmade snow. Facilities include 3,200 foot trestle car lift, sports lodge, rental shop and pro instructors. Skating rink, with artificial ice.

THE SPA—An internationally famous Spa with modern facilities for hydrotherapy, massage and other accepted forms of physical treatment, operated under medical supervision. Rates on request.

CHILDREN'S RECREATION—A supervised playground and indoor playroom.

INSTRUCTION—Lessons by appointment in golf, tennis, riding, swimming, shooting, dancing, skiing and skating.

AMUSEMENTS—Dancing nightly, except Sunday. Concerts daily, special program Sunday evening. Movies nightly, Television, Bridge, Canasta, Backgammon, Chess, Checkers, Gin Rummy, Ping Pong.

SHOPS AND SERVICES—Beauty Salon, Barber Shop, Chiropodist, Men's Shop, Western Union, Women's Wear Shop, Jewelry Shop, Linen Shop, Flower Shop, Footwear Shop, Newsstand and Tobacco Shop, Gift Shop, Soda Fountain, Pill Box, all within the hotel. Stock market quotations by Dow Jones Ticker Service. Dry Cleaning and Laundry, one-day service upon request. Motor cars available with or without drivers. Garage with lock stalls for storage.

DRESS—Informal daytime dress; Bermuda shorts or slacks at breakfast and luncheon, but men must wear coats in dining room. Evenings: cocktail or dinner dresses, dinner jackets predominate.

The eight tennis courts are always perfectly maintained. Courts are of En-Tout-Cas and Teniko Royal, with one all-weather surface court.



The Homestead's private spa is one of the best equipped hydrotherapeutic centers in the world. Its steam bath and massage facilities are also popular with active sports enthu-siasts—especially those who overdo it a bit at the start.

An elaborate buffet is served indoors or on the lawn at the casino for those who prefer an outdoor luncheon. There is outdoor dinner dancing in the formal gardens during midsummer.

The Grille, a handsome addition to The Homestead's dining facilities.






There are many comfortable lounges for games and reading. Games include billiards and pool, to mention just a few.

All-winter Skiing and Skating

Man-made snow and artificial ice has turned an occasional delight into a permanent winter attraction at The Homestead. The skiing is superb on a broad slope 3,200 feet long with a 500 foot drop—and on one mile of subsidiary trails. The newest snow-making equipment assures a good skiing surface from about December 15 to March 15 every year.





The winter sports lodge at the base of the ski run includes snack bar and restaurant, large open fireplace, sunning and observation deck, and pro shop's for buying or renting equipment.
