The 2nd day of the 11th Ministerial meeting of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization began this morning, 24 April 1953, with the Ministers of the fourteen NATO nations convening at 11 A.M. at the Palais de Chaillot in Paris, France. Following the morning session a press conference was held and another followed the afternoon session.

Lord Ismay, Secretary General of NATO, announced today that contracts have been signed for the manufacture in Europe of more than 550 million dollar's worth of combat aircraft for the Allied Forces. The United States government today signed off-shore procurement contracts for military aircraft to the total of 281,540,000 dollars with Belgium, France, The Netherlands and the United Kingdom. Here representatives of the various countries await their turn to sign the contracts.
