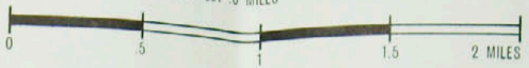

TRANSPORTATION FROM MANHATTAN

BY CAR. Take the Triborough Bridge, the Queensboro Bridge, or the Queens Midtown Tunnel. Connecting highways, clearly marked with blue-and-orange World's Fair signs, lead directly to the Fair. Parking near the grounds costs \$1.50 a day.

BY SUBWAY. (The subway emerges partway along the route to become an elevated train.) Take the IRT Flushing Line train at Times Square, at Fifth Avenue at 42nd, or at Grand Central Station, to Willets Point Boulevard. The BMT and IND subway systems have free transfer points to the IRT Flushing Line. Follow the blue arrows displayed in all stations. The fare is 15 cents (one subway token).

BY LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD. Trains leave from Pennsylvania Station about every 12 minutes. The fare is 50 cents one way, or \$2.50 for a round trip plus one admission to the Fair.

BY BUS. Gray Line buses leave hourly for the Fair, starting at 9 a.m., from midtown points convenient to most major hotels. The fare is \$1.00 one way.

BY TAXI. The fare from midtown New York, including bridge or tunnel toll, ranges upward from \$2.50, depending on point of departure and traffic conditions.

BY BOAT. Circle Line excursion boats run twice a day from Pier 81, West 41st Street, to the World's Fair Marina, close by the fairgrounds. Adult fares are \$2.75 to the Fair, \$2.00 for the return trip; for children under 12, \$1.25 to the Fair, \$1.00 return. The former Hudson River ferryboat *Orange* makes two round trips a day to the World's Fair Marina from the Battery. Rates are \$3.00 each way for adults, \$1.50 for children.

American Hydrofoils, Inc. provides speedy hydrofoil transportation from the marine terminal at East 25th Street. Rates are \$3.50 one way for adults, \$6.00 for a round trip, half fare for children.
