TOUR A (4 days)

Rome - Naples - Pompei - Amalfi - Sorrento - Capri - Anacapri - Naples - Rome

Operated daily, all the year round

1st day: ROME - FORMIA - NAPLES
Leave at 8:00 a.m. by CIAT deluxe motorcoach from CIT Office, Piazza della Repubblica 64. Arrive Naples at lunch time. Transportation to the hotel. Afternoon at disposal to visit Naples. Suggested excursion to Phlegrean Fields and Seicetra (add Lit. 1,600).

2nd day: NAPLES - POMPEI - AMALFI - SORRENTO

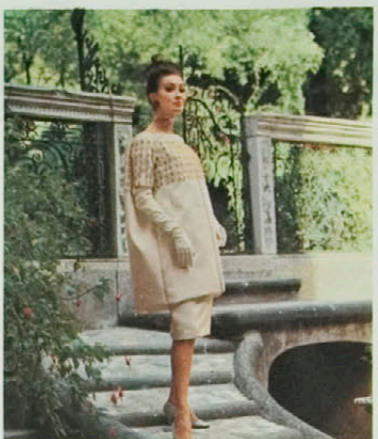
General conditions for all the tours

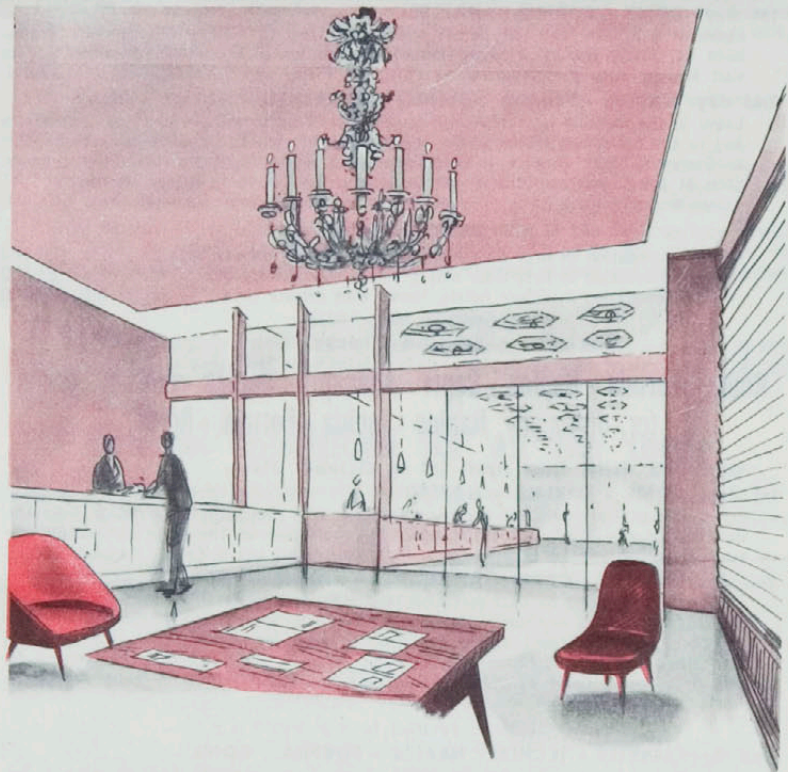

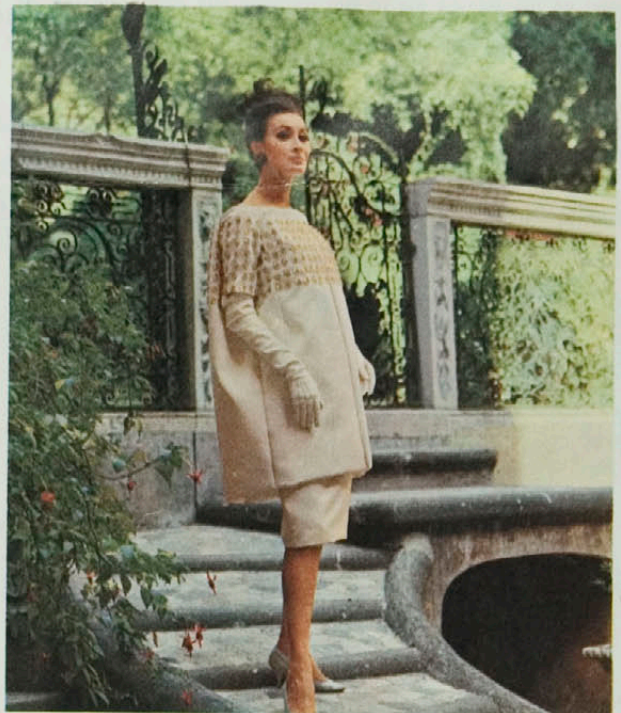

Rome by night

The Eternal City, when night falls, reveals wonderful aspects to the visitors which are emphasized by the contrast between its fountains sparkling in the lights and the imposing monuments mantled by the shadows.
